Later, in September 2004 he had a cystoscopy, and in the patient's most recent operation on 22/12/2004 TUK [illegible] catheterisation was carried out. The patient had a cystoscopy under general anaesthetic and subject to this, was admitted as an in-patient for TUR_T.

Radiological Findings:

Clinical Pattern: On the second day post op the patient had 3000 cc urine output, and on 01.04.2005 the tube was removed. Thereafter it was observed that the patient was able to pass water normally. It was decided to observe the patient until 04.04.2005. However, on the patient's written request to leave the hospital, it was decided to discharge him.
